To agree and adopt the Treasurers Report the profit and loss account, balance sheet 22/23 and Independent Review of Accounts

Mike Jones provided an overview of the accounts and reported that it had been a good financial year, with cash reserves in a very healthy position and that the "future looked good".

Mike stated the aim is for Essex Tennis to have its own Tennis Centre, and that facilities would have to be replaced within the next 30 years.

Mike explained that County Associations now receive grants from the LTA rather than registration fees paid by members. These grants are determined by the number of people who play tennis in the county, the availability of Park Tennis Schemes, Junior Performance Tennis, Disability/ Inclusive Tennis and Padel/Pickleball.

The figures were reviewed by the Chartered Accountant and given a glowing review. Mike expressed his thanks to Joanne White.

Mike Jones explained that Essex Tennis currently was investing £600,000 in the stock market, managed by Crocus Wealth, our professional financial advisor. Mike asked for approval to invest a further £200,000.

To discuss the update in respect of the already agreed changes to a "Charitable Incorporated Organisation" (CIO)

Paul Marks provided an update on "Our move to CIO status in 2024"

- April 2024 Application/Constitution submitted to Charities Commission
- September 2024 EGM to Finalise CIO status with members
- Up till October 1st Essex Tennis will continue to operate in the same way
- October 1st 2024 Move to new trustee status (following the LTA funding model) this
 model is being used by a large number of other councils/counties.
- As Trustees cannot sit on the council for more than 9 years a plan is in place to ensure the necessary rotation
- January 2025 will be the final AGM following the old structure
- January 2026 will be the first AGM of the new structure

Alan Rayner expressed the hard work and hours that had gone into this change and thanked Mike Jones, Paul Marks, Juliet O'Mahony and Clive Rippon for their contributions. He then asked for any comments. There were no comments.
